Life Group Questions – November 19, 2017 Catalysts for Spiritual Growth – Personal Ministry

1. Share a Christian service opportunity you have had, either in or outside the church. What was meaningfu to you through that outlet to serve? What effect did it have on you?
2. What would be possible impediments to your serving Christ through the church? What might be challenging for you to serve?
3. Read 1 Peter 4:10-11 carefully. What observations can you make about serving from this passage?
4. We have identified serving as a God-given catalyst to spiritual growth. Because of that, more is accomplished than just what is done for others. As we are selfless in serving others, we are actually beneficiaries of our own service. How does God strengthen our faith through serving? In what way have you been personally blessed and grown in your faith by serving?
5. One of our Vision goals is that everyone in our church would serve God with the gifts he has given them. Is there a sense of a call on your life to serve in some capacity? Do you have a dream to serve God in a specific way? What steps could you take to realize that dream? If you are not currently serving, what would it take for you to "get in the game" and begin?
6. Is there a way that your Life Group could take on a service project? What might that look like?
7. If you are unsure of how God has equipped you to serve, consider taking the SHAPE course in the new year.
