The Book of Esther: Fingerprints of the Unseen God
Part 3 – Courageous in Calamity

1. What was your thought process like when you had to make a major decision in our life that not only affected you but others around you? What were some of the major factors or criteria used to help you decide what to do?

2. Given the current situation of life that you are in, is there a way you could use your influence or position for the glory of God? It could be to affect one person or a multitude of people. It could be in your family, at your work place, at school, in the government, or some other area.

3. A simple definition of Providence is God's divine guidance, care and provision. It can also be seen as God's power sustaining and watching over His creation. In the book of Esther, we see God's Providence in using Esther to intercede for her people. If she was not willing to do it, then Mordecai insists that God would save His people some other way. In what ways do you see God's providence in your life?

4. In what areas of your life is the Lord asking you to be more sacrificial and/or to take a risk? Is there something that you are putting off doing because of fear, doubt or unbelief?
