

**Life Group Questions – February 11, 2018**  
**The Book of Esther: Fingerprints of the Unseen God**  
**Part 5 – Let The Celebration Begin!**

1. As we conclude this series on Esther, what are some of the big lessons or challenges that the Lord has spoken to you through this story?

2. In chapter eight we see an outburst of emotion on Esther's part for her own people where she is weeping at the King's feet. What would it take for you to have such an outburst of emotion in prayer to God for someone in need in your life? Have you ever felt like that during a time of intercession? Think of one person who you could reach with the gospel and share the word of God with them or invite them to Alpha.

3. Thanksgiving, remembrance, glorifying God for His work in our lives, etc., are all important aspects of praise that we should have in our lives. How often do you take time to praise God? Do you have a yearly "Feast of Purim" where you remember God's work in your life? What are the benefits to your spiritual life by celebrating God's provision, protection, deliverance, and hand in your life?

4. If you were to write an autobiography about your life (the story of your life!), what incidents and experiences would you include? Why would you include those specific experiences?
