

**Life Group Questions – May 13, 2018**  
**Worship—It's what You were Made for – Part 5**  
**Worship in Music**

1. What is a meaningful spiritual piece of music for you? Why is it significant?

2. What influence has music played in your life? Has it been spiritually helpful or detrimental? How did that happen?

3. Read Zephaniah 3:17. This prophecy is written to encourage God's people who had been sent into exile because of their sin and promises God's forgiveness and restoration. What amazes you about the content of this verse as it reveals an aspect of our God to us? If worship is responding to the revelation of who God is and what he does, in a way that demonstrates his worthiness and glory, how would this inspire you to worship? What would you worship God for?

4. Musical worship is an integral component of our corporate gatherings. Read Psalm 138:1. Because God is the focus of our worship we are instructed to sing with all our heart. If we considered that God was our audience in worship, what would it look like to sing with all our heart?

5. Read Colossians 3:16. One function of corporate musical worship is mutual encouragement and edification. Singing to other believers has the purpose of teaching and admonishing or warning them. What is the basis for this practice in this verse? How might you be mindful of fellow Christians in our gatherings?
