Life Group Questions May 27, 2018

1. What is a time you disobeyed your parents and it had consequences? How did you feel about your disobedience? How did it reflect a lack of love and honor toward your parents?

2. As a child were you generally compliant or tending to be more rebellious? Do you have the same characteristics or have you changed?

3. Read Deuteronomy 26:16-19. Moses is preparing the Israelites for life in the promised land without him. What does God ask of them? How did God see his covenant people? What blessing is there for his obedient people?

4. We said that God demands our worship and that involves loving him totally. Jesus said that to love him involves obeying him (John 14:15). Jesus said that the mission of the church is to help people become followers of Jesus, baptize them and in an ongoing way to teach them to obey the commands of Jesus. The focus of our Life Groups is application or obeying what Jesus is teaching us. Have you taken the step of baptism? If not, what is holding you back?

5. What is a blessing you have received because you began to practice something that has been taught? What is an area that you are struggling to bring into submission to Christ? Is there something your group members can pray for you in this regard?
