

Life Group Questions – September 16, 2018
Ripples—Touching our World through Jesus – Love (Luke 10:25-37)

1. What is an occasion that someone has made a difference in your life? How did God use that person? What did it mean to you?

2. What is a time you have been used to help someone else? What effect did that have on you?

3. Read Luke 10:25-29. Our responsibility to God is to love him with the totality of our being and to love our neighbor as our self. Read James 2:8 and Galatians 5:13. What is significant about these verses? How can loving our neighbor be the distillation of all the commandments?

4. Read 1 John 4:19; John 15:12; and John 13:34-35. What do we learn about love from these verses?

5. We are called to make a difference in our world. Why might you not reach out in love to help someone else? What the Good Samaritan did and what we need to do is to identify opportunities, be touched by Jesus' compassion, help anyone indiscriminately, and use the resources we have. Of these four items, which do you need God to work in you?

6. Pray for your needs and the needs of others you can help. Commit to touching a life every day this week and come prepared to share your experiences next week.
