Ripples—Touching our World Through Jesus
It's Not Okay (Amos 2:6-16)

1. Have you ever experienced injustice in any way? What happened and how did it make you feel? What were the results?

2. List as many words as you can that express injustice, i.e. discrimination, exploitation, etc. How broad is this sin?

3. Read Isaiah 1:10-17. God told his people he didn't want them to offer any more sacrifices. The strange thing is that he was the one who required this from them. Why did he not want them to come to worship him any more (see 1:15b-17). What was so offensive to him? What do we learn from this?

4. Read James 1:26-27. What does religion or faith that God accepts look like? What does James criticize the church for in James 2:1-13. What other examples of favoritism might we see in the church?

5. Is there one kind of injustice that bothers you more than another? Why is that the case?

6. In what way could you touch our broken and unjust world with the love of Jesus in such a way that it makes a difference?
