

Life Group Questions – November 25, 2018
Victorious—Winning the Spiritual Battle
Dress for Success—Ephesians 6:10-20

1. In the five messages on spiritual warfare, which topic did you find most enlightening or helpful? Satan, demons and angels; the world system and corrupted environment; the flesh or sinful self; and the armor of God? What was it that spoke to you? What significance is there for your life?

2. Read 2 Corinthians 10:1-5. This passage highlights the spiritual nature of the battle we are in (i.e. not a flesh and blood struggle or merely a physical fight). Because this is a spiritual battle, we need to use appropriate weaponry. The battle is in the mind and it is the mind in which our troubles begin. What contribution does Romans 12:2 make to understanding this issue? What is the key to our thinking that gives us victory in spiritual warfare?

3. Which of the weapons we have been given to be able to stand against the enemy's attack is most pertinent for you (Ephesians 6:14-17)? Truth, righteousness, the gospel of peace, faith, the Spirit with the Word of God, prayer. What is significant for you about that weapon? Why?

4. Prayer is a critical discipline for being victorious in spiritual warfare. Read Ephesians 6:18-20. In what way is prayer both a defensive weapon as well as an offensive weapon? What observations have you made about prayer from these verses?

5. One of the great benefits of going to be with Jesus after we die is that we will no longer struggle with sin or temptation. We will be able to obey God naturally and without any impediment. What battle, that you currently face, will you be grateful to no longer have?
